

FOREWORD

Dhemaji College, a leading higher education institution affiliated to Dibrugarh University, had a humble beginning as an institution of lighting the lamp in the field of higher education in Dhemaji district in 1965.

The college was the fruition of a long cherished dream of the people of Dhemaji district who under the inspiring leadership of the leading citizens of the



district had to resort to a popular step aiming the establishment of the college in this northern part of the state. This step was ultimately crowned with success when the college was formally established on August 1, 1965. It was in gratitude to those dedicated people of Dhemaji district that the college named as Dhemaji College. The establishment of Dhemaji College was a bold and positive step towards the spread of higher education in this northern part of Assam.

Dhemaji College is the oldest and premier institution of higher learning in the district of Dhemaji. At present it imparts education from higher secondary to degree level in Arts and Science streams along with different parallel, career-oriented, vocational, skill-enhancement and add-on courses with an experience and efficient teaching staff. Dhemaji College has, in 59 years of its existence, carved a niche for itself in the educational firmament of Dhemaji district, nay the entire north bank of Assam.

The college also offers programmes like Post-Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA), Certificate Course in Computer Application, Web Design, Bio-fertilizer: Vermicompost Technology, Mushroom Culture, apart from add-on courses offered by different departments. The college offers Dibrugarh University approved supervisor to guide Ph.D. Programme in Electronics along with Ph. D. Research Laboratory in Electronics approved by Dibrugarh University.

The college possesses separate Administrative building, class rooms for different classes, departmental block for different departments, library building, conference halls, common rooms for boys and girls, Indoor Sports Hall, Language Laboratory, Computer Laboratory with well-equipped infrastructure facilities. Moreover the institution has a large campus with spacious play ground, canteen facilities, and drinking water facilities with an ideal academic environment. The College provides ample opportunities to the students for performance and development of their talents in the field of educational, cultural, literary, games and sports and other co-curricular activities.

The Children Education and Career Development Centre (CECDC), Dhemaji College is one of the valuable assets not only for Dhemaji College, but also for the entire District, offering multi-activity facility for the students to develop their talents and performances. The college provides adequate facilities for research and extension activities. The college has completed several Major and Minor Research Projects undertaken by the faculty members under the sponsorship of UGC, DST, etc. The extension activities of the college are further extended through Equal Opportunity Cell, Women Cell, NCC, NSS, Eco-Club, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Mission, IIC, etc.

The College possesses two Automatic Weather Information Centres under the sponsorship of Assam Science, Technology and Environmental Council (ASTEC), Govt. of Assam.

A beautiful Botanical Garden, Green House, Orchid House, Seed Bank (GeneSys DC), Mushroom Hub, Vermi-Compost unit, etc. are some of the assets and attractions of the institution.

The college has been conferred as College of Centre with Potential for Excellence (CPE - I) status by the UGC in 2010. Dhemaji College celebrated the Concluding Ceremony of glorious Golden Jubilee in the Year 2016-2017.

The college was first Accredited by NAAC in 2004. Dhemaji College was Re-accredited by NAAC in 2012. and graded B++ in 2023 in the 3rd Cycle Assessment and Accreditation. The college has been participating in the NIRF ranking since 2020-2021.

In accordance with the guidelines of the Govt. of Assam, and curriculum structure of Dibrugarh University, Dhemaji College has been initiating initiatives to implement the Four-Year Undergraduate program, along with other provisions, in the spirit of NEP (2020) since the academic session 2023-24.

KEY FEATURES OF NEP (2020) FOR UG PROGRAMME

MULTIPLE ENTRY AND EXITS:

In accordance with NEP (2020) and course structure of Dibrugarh University, the Dhemaji College offers four-year Under-Graduate program in all the subjects, with provision for multiple entries and exits.

Exit 1: There is provision for exit after successful completion of 1 year (2 semesters). Students would be provided Under-Graduate Certificate.

Exit 2: There is provision for exit after successful completion of 2 years (4 semesters). Students would be provided Under-Graduate Diploma.

Exit 3: After successful completion of 3 years (6 semesters), a student would be provided Under-Graduate / Bachelor degree (in the field of study / discipline).

Change of Major subject: After 2nd semester, a student may opt to change the Major subject within the broad discipline.

Change of Minor subject: After 3rd semester, a student may opt to change the Minor subject.

Academic Bank of credit (ABC): ABC is an academic service mechanism as a digital / virtual / online entity established and managed by the Ministry of Education / University Grants Commission. The students shall have an academic account with the ABC where credits accrued by him/her shall be recorded to facilitate credit recognition, accumulation, transfer and redemption for award of the degree as well as for transfer of institution.

A. HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE (ARTS) (INTAKE CAPACITY: 240)

C. FOUR-YEAR UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMME

- 1. Apart from Major subject, students can opt for any one subject as Minor.
- 2. For B.A. programme, the Minor subjects are Assamese, Computer Application, Economics, Education, English, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Political Science and Sociology.
- 3. For B.Sc. programme, the Minor subjects are Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science and Application, Electronics, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology.
- 4. Students opting for Zoology as Major / Honours can choose either Chemistry or Botany as Minor subject.

- 5. Students opting for Botany as Major / Honours can choose either Chemistry or Zoology as Minor subject.
- 6. Students opting for Chemistry as Major / Honours can choose either Physics, Electronics, Mathematics, Botany or Zoology as Minor subject.
- 7. Students opting for Physics as Major / Honours can choose either Chemistry, Electronics, Mathematics, Botany or Zoology as Minor subject

ADMISSION PROCESS

A. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

a. Higher Secondary

The admission process shall start following the declaration of the results by the Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA). The admission for 2024-25 session shall be done through DARPAN portal of the Govt. of Assam (<u>www.darpan.ahseconline.in</u>). The intending candidates are advised to fill up the application form through the portal, and select Dhemaji College, Dhemaji as institution. The admission schedule and the list of selected students shall be notified in the website of the Dhemaji College, Dhemaji (<u>www.dhemajicollege.in</u>). The candidates may also log on to the DARPAN portal to know about their selection in Dhemaji College.

b. Undergraduate Courses

- The Prospectus (2024-25) shall be available for download at the website of the Dhemaji College, Dhemaji (www.dhemajicollege.in). The students are to go through the prospectus before applying.
- Applicants must apply through SAMARTH e-Gov Portal <u>https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in</u> (Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal on SAMARTH). Candidates who apply through SAMARTH Portal will only be considered for admission.
- After filling up of application form and uploading all the relevant documents for admission in the college admission portal, a pdf file will be generated. A print out of the pdf file must be brought / submitted by the applicant during the time of admission.
- Filling up of the application form in college admission portal requires a DHE unique id, which can be generated by logging into the DHE portal <u>https://dheonlineadmission.amtron.in</u>
- The 1st, 2nd & 3rd Merit List will be notified in the College website <u>www.dhemajicollege.in</u>. The applicants are advised to check the college website regularly for updates on merit list, fee structure and dates of admission.

B. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED DURING ADMISSION

- 2. Marksheet and certificate of the qualifying examination.
- 3. Marksheet and certificate of HSLC and HS (for UG courses).
- 4. Age proof (Birth Certificate / HSLC Admit card)
- 5. Caste Certificate (if applicable) for candidates selected under reserved categories.
- 6. Character certificate from the institution last attended.
- 7. Gap Certificate, for candidates who passed qualifying examination in 2022 or earlier.
- 8. Domicile certificate (EPIC, AADHAR, PRC, etc. of the applicant or his/her parent(s).
- 9. Certificate of Co-curricular activities (if applicable)
- 10. Certificate of Physical disability (for PwD candidates) (if applicable)
- 11. EWS certificate for candidates belonging to the category (if applicable)
- 12. Unique ID (The ID should be generated from the website of the Director of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam) by using the link <u>https://dheonlineadmission.amtron.in/sp/</u>

- 13. Affidavits on Anti-Ragging by student as well as parent / guardian to be submitted during admission.
- 14. Transfer / Migration Certificate from institute last attended (for applicants other than those who passed from SEBA and AHSEC).

Additional documents required for candidates seeking admission under Govt. Fee Waiver Scheme:

- 1. A declaration (shall be provided by the college at the time of admission).
- 2. One photograph of plantation of a sapling.
- 3. Family income certificate issued by competent authority (i.e. Circle Office). Income should be less than Rupees 2 lakh *per annum*.

C. ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for Higher secondary course:

Candidate should have passed High School Leaving Certificate (Class X) from any recognized board.

Eligibility for B.A. (Four year Degree Course) Programme:

- (i) Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination (Arts/Science/Commerce) with good academic record.
- (ii) For Honours Course, Candidate should possess a good marks in aggregate as well as in the concerned subject in the H.S.(10+2) Final Examination.

Eligibility for B.Sc Programme :

- (i) Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination (Science) with good academic record.
- (ii) For Honours Course, Candidate should possess a good marks in aggregate as well as in the concerned subject in the H.S.(10+2) Final Examination.

Eligibility for Post Graduate Diploma in Compute Application (PGDCA):

Graduate in any discipline with good academic record.

Eligibility for Certificate Course in Computer Application: H.S.L.C. (Class X)

D. RESERVATION OF SEATS

(i) The College follows the policy of reservation of seats for students belonging to S.C./S.T.(P)/S.T.(H)/OBC/ MOBC / EWS as per Government Rules.

(ii) Few seats are also reserved for the students having outstanding performances in the field of sports, culture, NCC and other co-curricular activities as per Government Rules.

(iii) Moreover, reservation of seats is also applicable for differently-abled / physically challenged students.

These seats are allotted on the basis of merit-cum-proficiency in the concerned field and candidates seeking admission against reserved quota in sports, culture, NCC and other cocurricular activities have to submit attested copies of certificates regarding their proficiency in the concerned field along with Admission Form.

E. HOSTEL ADMISSION

Candidates opting for hostel seat have to apply through the Dhemaji college website Hostel admission portal (<u>www.dhemajicollege.in</u>) separately. The allotment of seats to the selected applicants for Hostel Admission will be notified in the college website as well as the notice board of the college. The selected candidates for Hostel accommodation shall have to pay the necessary hostel admission fee within the stipulated period of time as fixed by the College Authority, otherwise Hostel seat will be cancelled.

Hostel Rules:

1. The students should report to the Superintendent(s) of the Hostel for Hostel Admission.

2. The boarders must maintain discipline and honest life style inside and outside of the Hostel.

3. Boarders must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Hostel prescribed by the College Authority, violation of which is subjected to disciplinary action including expulsion from the Hostel and College.

4. Boarders must abide by all the rules and regulations of 'Dhemaji College Hostel Rules'.

5. The hostel admission will be reserved only for one academic year. The admission in the hostel in each academic year will be based on academic performance-cum-merit basis in Annual/Final Exams.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

- 1. Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building and students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. They are subjected to the Rules and Regulations of the College.
- 2. The students admitted to the college must abide by all Rules and Regulations as prescribed by the College Authority. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, showing discourtesy to the teachers and the staff members in any form, adopting unfair means during examination etc. are some of the offences which make students liable for disciplinary actions.
- 3. Regular attendance in class for all students is compulsory. Students must attend at least 75% of the total classes held, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.
- 4. Internal examinations like Unit Test, Terminal Examination, Test Examination, Seminar, Assignment, etc. are compulsory for all students.
- 5. Attendance in the seminars/workshops/other academic as well as co-curricular activities organized by the department and college is compulsory for the students.
- 6. All the powers for maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal and his decision shall be final in all such matters.
- 7. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college.

ACCOMODATION

The college provides accommodation facilities to the eligible students of the college. The college has one Girls' Hostel and one Boys' Hostel within the college campus. The hostel seats are allotted on merit basis. Moreover, few seats are reserved for the students belonging from reserved categories. The accommodation facilities in details are as follows:

REGISTRATION

The newly admitted Higher Secondary and Four Year Degree Course students have to be registered under Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and Dibrugarh University (DU) respectively. Registration Form in this regard can be obtained from the Registration Branch of Dhemaji College and the students have to submit the filled in registration form to the Registration Branch of the college within the stipulated period of time as fixed by the College Authority.

EXAMINATION AND EXAMINATION RULES

- 1. Terminal / Test Examinations for all students are to be held as mentioned in the Academic Calendar. Moreover, students are required to appear in Unit Tests in different subjects conducted by the department concerned.
- Students must appear in all of these examinations and secure a minimum qualifying mark. Any student who fails to fulfill this condition will not be allowed to appear in the final examination of Board / University.
- 3. Date of Final Examination of Board/University will be notified by the AHSEC/DU respectively.
- 4. Promotion to next higher class as well as allowing a student to appear in the final examination conducted by AHSEC/DU are governed by College/AHSEC/DU Rules

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME

The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LICI) has launched a Group Insurance Scheme for College Students for bringing under the Insurance coverage at a subsidized rate of premium. The scheme is offered to the college students under 1(one) year renewable Group Term assurance plan. On every annual renewal, the scheme is to be renewed for getting insurance coverage of the students for their subsequent academic year.

Dhemaji College has introduced this scheme under MOU with the LICI, Dhemaji Branch with a insurance covering of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) at the annual rate of premium of Rs. 23/- (Twenty Three) only. The premium is collected at the time of admission. The benefit under the scheme is the insured sum payable to the nominee in case of death of the students during the policy year for which premium is received.

STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION

The Dhemaji College Students' Union (DCSU) is the general body of the students of the College. Its membership is compulsory for every student of the College. Office bearers of DCSU are elected annually by the students according to the Constitution of DCSU and have to work under the guidance of Prof. in-Charge of respective section/department of the DCSU.

The college has formed a Legal Awareness Club with active corporation form District Sessions Judges Court and District Legal Cell. The College offers wide scope for Research & Extension Activities. The college has a strong foundation for research and extension activities in different fields. Dhemaji College has already completed several Minor Research Projects and Major Research Projects sponsored by UGC and DST run by the faculty members in different departments.

At present there is one Ph. D. Research Guide in the college under the approval of Dibrugarh University. The Ph. D. Research Guide is Dr. Dipak Kr. Neog in the department of Electronics.

The college conducts extension and other related activities through its different wings.

AGRO-SHED, GREEN HOUSE AND SEED BANK

The college possesses an agro-shed to conserve local flora including medicinal plants. Moreover, the college also has a Green House for rare, endangered and threatened species of plants, including Orchids and Medicinal Plants. The Department of Botany maintains a Mushroom hub and a plantation of food trees of Muga Silk moth.

There is a seed bank in the college named GeneSys-DC which is a germplasm reserve of the seeds of local varieties of rice, other food crops as well as wild species of plants.
