

Activities Report: Session 2005-2006

WORKSHOP ON AIDS AWARENESS: The NSS, Dhemaji College, Dhemaji organized an Awareness Programme on AIDS in collaboration with State AIDS Control Society, Government of Assam on 11th January, 2005 at Dhemaji College, Dhemaji.

The Report: The day long programme started with an inter-institutional Prize Money Quiz Competition under the assistance of State AIDS Control Society, Dhemaji District. There were altogether seven High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools and four Degree Level Colleges from the locality took part in the Competition. The Quiz Competition was conducted by Sri Diganta Hazarika, Lecturer, Dept. of Economics, Dhemaji College, Dhemaji and Sri B. Phukan, EAC, Dhemaji. The teams from the following institutions secured the first, second and third position respectively.

3 rd Prize	The Dhemaji Girls' College, Dhemaji	3 rd Prize –Rs.500/ Cash, Trophy and Certificate of Proficiency
