Meaning

Federation – Confederation – confusecommon root – but meanings are different

A confederation is a union of group of sovereign nations or states in which the central govt. is weak and the component states retain considerable independence -

The members of a confederation often delegate only a few powers to the central authority -

In confederation, members states or local governments enjoy supreme power or sovereignty – event they have allowed to nullify a federal law -



It is established for some common purposes or critical issues — defence, foreign relations, internal trade or currency etc.



German Confederation from 1815-1840 Swiss Confederation from 1781 – 1789. European Union (EU), Commonwealth of Independent States

Basic Features

- Voluntary Union of Sovereign States -
- Central Authority is relatively weak -
- Right to Secession (Temporary Union)
- **Establish for Common Purposes -**
- **Confederation is a Loose Union -**
- New Sovereignty doesn't come -
