Judicial Review — to review the laws passes by the Parliament and state legislatures and the acts of federal and state executives, rejected as unconstitutional/null and void - protects the Constitution



Court of Record (129) — Its judgment is unquestionable and accepted by all lower courts – decision of the SC is considered as final
