The UNO – Maintenance of International Peace and Security – **Article 13(B)** – **General Assembly and Human Rights** – **January, 1946** **Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC)**

Preamble - Ideals and objectives of the UDHR – **Respect for Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms**



Right to Equality – **Article - 1**



Right against Discrimination – **Article -2**



Civil and Political Rights – (Article 3 – 21)

Right to Life; Liberty and Security; Right against slavery; Right against torture, inhuman and degrading treatment; Right to equality before law; Right to innocence; Right to privacy; Right to freedom of movement and residence; Right to nationality; Right to family; Right to property; Right to protection; Right to fair public hearing; Right to form Government; Right to public service etc.

Social, Economic and Cultural Rights –



(Article 22 – 27) **Right to social security**; Right to work; **Right against discrimination in employment**; Equal pay for equal work; **right to leisure**; **right to just and favourable remuneration**; Right to form Trade Unions; **Right to a standard of living**; Right to education; **Cultural rights**; **Right to intellectual property**;
