# The Preamble

**“We the People of India, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic republic and to ensure to all citizens:**

**Justice, social, economic and political:**

**Liberty of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship:**

**Equality of status and opportunity and promote among them all:**

**Fraternity of assuring dignity of our individual and the unity and integrity of the nation:**

**IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty sixth day of November, 1949 do hereby adopt, enact and give to ourselves this constitution.”**
